## **President's Report ~ Year-End 2010**

It is with great joy that I write this year-end report for 2010 as I have witnessed perpetual service provided through Global Alliance for Balance and Healing from January to December. Our Monthly Global Healing Day clinics, Host Communities and Community Outreach programs have been well attended and our list of invitations to serve has grown.

We began this year with an executive board of five voting administrators along with our usual Secretarial Officer and Financial Officer. This larger board has managed a greater scope of responsibility with great efficacy. I (Wendy) am grateful to Elizabeth Sullivan, Brianne Molette, Meg Bourget and Gary Hicklin for their willingness to administrate for Global Alliance. I am grateful, as well, to Kathleen Schaefer and Ann Melvin for filling their roles as board officers and support staff.

2010 launched with an introduction meeting for new Healing Team Volunteers on January 6 and our Annual Healing Team Training on February 5 & 6 in which our entire team met for fine tuning.

We held our first Global Healing Day clinic at Sierra Vista Hospital on Saturday, January 16, as the product of a renewed agreement with the hospital to use their public auditorium for the entire year of 2010. With the exception of our May 15 clinic, which was held at the Santa Margarita Community Hall, our subsequent monthly clinics held at Sierra Vista Hospital were on February 20, March 20, April 17, June 19, July 17, August 21, September 18, October 16, November 20 and December 18. As always we have continued to hold our GHD clinics from 11am to 4pm on the third Saturday of each month.

Global Alliance Community Outreach commenced with the first Toning Group facilitated by Karly Schmitt on Thursday, January 14, at 6:30pm. Karly facilitated subsequent Toning Groups on Wednesday, February 1, Wednesday, March 24, Friday, April 23, Monday, May 10, Tuesday, June 15, and Friday July 9 at 6:30pm at the center. In August the executive board decided to hold the Toning Groups on the fourth Tuesday evening of each month and to rotate the facilitators with the intent to provide more continuity to our guests as they developed their toning abilities. Subsequent Toning Groups were provided on August 24, September 28, October 26, November 23 and December 28 at 6:30pm at the center and rotating facilitators were Karly Schmitt, Wendy McKenna, Elizabeth Sullivan and Meg Bourget.

Other Community Outreach programs held in 2010 were; I (Wendy) channeled the Humanity Meditation on January 27, March 18, April 21, May 26, July 15, September 23, November 11 and December 21 and I collected donations for Global Alliance at these events.

Global Alliance hosted Lee Carroll and a KRYON channeling in Santa Margarita at the Community Hall on February 27. Elizabeth Sullivan facilitated "DNA Expansion through Pineal

Activation” on March 15 and she facilitated “Symbols as a Gateway to Truth” on May 1; Mutsumi Shopshear facilitated “Living Harmoniously with Animals” on July 24; I (Wendy) facilitated “Balance Be” on September 14 and October 12, all of which were held at the center.

We have retained the Santa Margarita Community Hall for periodic use when we need it at a non-profit discount rental rate.

Global Alliance healing team served Host Communities in Cambria, California and Los Lunas, New Mexico and Westminster, Colorado.

We filmed a “one minute message” for public media on July 31. A reduced rate on this service was gifted to us by SLO.org. We attached this video message to our website. The Global Alliance website was transformed this year by a dynamic committee of volunteers and administrators. The site is continually updated and still proves to be our best medium for public education on our service; balance. Elizabeth Sullivan has perpetuated her “Messages from the Holy Spirit” on the website as well and we receive many positive reviews on these.

Kelly Metcalf of Harmony House Yoga hosted a fundraising event at her yoga studio in Pismo Beach on Saturday, September 25. Kelly raised funds for Global Alliance during this full day event. I (Wendy) held a fundraising class on “Energetics” from March 9<sup>th</sup> to 11<sup>th</sup> and from August 2<sup>nd</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> to raise funds for Global Alliance.

The healing team enjoyed our Annual Retreat on Saturday, November 13. All of the team attended and the day was spent in Santa Margarita and Atascadero, California.

Global Alliance established a Friday Yoga Group at the Santa Margarita Community Hall from 9 to 10am each week. This group is attended regularly by seven healing team volunteers and others from the community. This has proven to be a great personal discipline for all participants!

I networked with administrators with ACEP and ISSEEM to establish relations with the intent to collaborate. And I have maintained close vigilance over the property we desire to purchase for our permanent center in Santa Margarita as we continue to strategize the prospective purchase of this land.

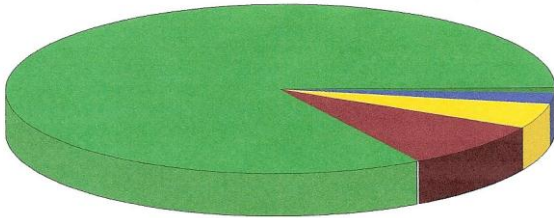
Global Alliance volunteers met for our year-end holiday dinner at Buona Tavola in San Luis Obispo on Thursday, December 30.

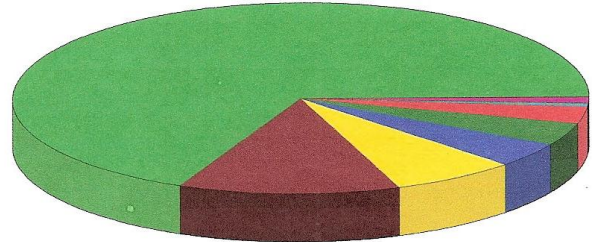

**Revenue and Expenditures**

To provide the services of energy balancing and education, Global Alliance for Balance and Healing relies on donations from direct public support.

Global Alliance for Balance and Healing has cash assets of \$13,897.22. Of these funds, \$10,162.16 is restricted and designated for a permanent facility; \$3,735.06 is unrestricted. Other assets are held as furniture and office equipment. Global Alliance has no outstanding debt.

All revenue goes to support Global Alliance programs. Services offered by Global Alliance include energy balancing clinics, seminars, workshops that provide channeled and guided meditations, and a variety of community outreach programs. Revenue from donations totaled \$17,601.65.

Global Alliance received total revenue of \$21,103.30 with total expenditures of \$23,816.13 leaving net revenue of -\$2,712.83 for the 2010 year.

Donations may be made online through PayPal.

Cash donations may be made in person at the Global Alliance Healing Center in Santa Margarita California. Checks or Money Orders may be made out to Global Alliance and mailed to PO Box 52, Santa Margarita CA 93453.

Any taxpayer over 70-1/2 years of age with an Individual Retirement Account (IRA) must receive a Required Minimum Distributions (RMD) from their IRA each year. Amounts donated to a qualified charity such as Global Alliance fulfill this requirement but are not counted as taxable income. You can request that your IRA administrator donate all or a portion of your RMD directly to Global Alliance.

Securities such as stocks and bonds can be donated to a qualified charity such as Global Alliance. The donor will avoid capital gains tax on any appreciated securities through this type of donation. In addition the donor receives a tax deduction for the fair market value of the securities as of the date of the donation. You can ask your broker to donate securities to Global Alliance.

To make a bequest to Global Alliance contact our administrator with the nature of your estate gift. Global Alliance will help facilitate your desire to bestow a legacy gift. You will need to have the bequest to Global Alliance legally included in your Last Will and Testament.

Global Alliance is able to accept gifts of any nature. There are important benefits available through estate planning and financing in cooperation with a nonprofit organization. It is suggested that donors confer with their tax advisors to determine how each of these giving opportunities may apply to individual tax situations.

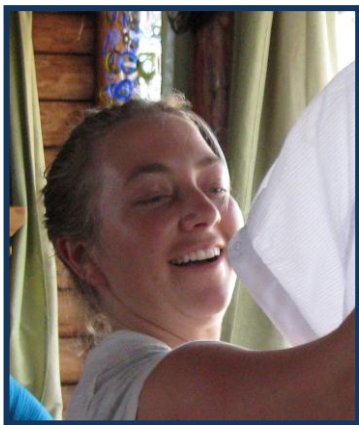
